We have reviewed the Colorado Wastewater Utility Council's letter dated April 13, 2009 in which you request a meeting to discuss possible approaches to revise the State's antidegradation regulations and guidance. We are willing to meet with the Colorado Wastewater Utility Council (Council). The Water Quality Control Division (Division) intends to present a proposal for antidegradation reviews at the Water Quality Forum, Basic Standards Work Group meeting scheduled for May 19, 2009. We would suggest not scheduling a separate meeting between the Council and the Division until after the Basic Standards Work Group meeting. Depending upon the outcome of this meeting, we can then decide on the best approach for proceeding with antidegradation reviews.
