Colorado Wastewater Utility Council

Policy Document 002 Membership

Regular Membership:

- Utility, District, Company, Federal, State, or Local government agencies that are actively involved in the treatment or collection of wastewater in the state of Colorado.
- A member may designate a primary and alternate representative to the Council.
- The primary representative shall have the right to cast one vote on all items of Council business, including amendments to the Council's Bylaws.
- If the primary representative is absent then voting right shall be granted to the alternate representative.
- Membership shall be determined by payment of annual dues and designation of a representative and an alternate.

Associate Membership:

- A Consultant, Engineering firm or Business that is actively involved in the design of wastewater treatment or collection systems in the state of Colorado.
- This membership shall designate a primary and alternate representative to the Council.
- This class of membership has no voting rights.

Institutions and Organizations:

- Educational Institutions or not-for-profit organizations that have a commitment to ensuring the environmental quality of treated wastewater in communities across Colorado are eligible for membership.
- This membership shall designate a primary and alternate representative to the Council.
- This class of membership has no voting rights.
